As a “hard rock” mine, once ore is extracted at our Waihi operation it is ground to a fine powder and then a cyanidation chemical process is applied to extract the gold and silver. Cyanide has been used for over 130 years for gold and silver recovery in the mining industry, and today the cyanidation process accounts for approximately 90% of gold retrieval worldwide.
