Amenity Effects Programme (AEP) Payments

Despite our mining operations being conducted within consent compliance limits, we recognise that some residents close to mining activities may experience a perceived reduction of amenity from time to time.

The Amenity Effects Programme was established in 2007. We make payments twice a year to qualifying residents, based on any vibration effects measured over the previous six-month period.

If you are already enrolled in the AEP and your property has qualified for payment in the latest cycle, you should by now have received a letter confirming your eligibility and the specific payment amount.

If you are not currently enrolled in the programme but your property has qualified for payment in the latest cycle, OceanaGold representatives are currently visiting those properties with the necessary forms and details to sign up to the programme if you wish.
